August 23, 2022, 2022: Parks Trails and Tree's Committee Meeting Notes

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm
- 2. Approved July 26th, 2022, meeting minutes.
- 3. Discussion on upcoming grants from Nancy O'Toole. On tree's grants that are available, and she wanted the Parks, Trails and Tree's Committee Blessing on proceeding with the paperwork for requests.
- 4. There were for committee members at the meeting. All of them agreed that she should proceed with both grants.
- 5. The shoulder of road on 200 East and Interlocken Rd. Was discussed. The question was raised about how patrons to the dog park the need to have to park along the walking trail and the shoulder of the road in the unpaved area East of the dog park fence instead of within the paved parking lot located North of the Restrooms. A question was raised about fencing and landscaping options that they would like to propose to the board and council about installing along the should of the road to vehicle traffic down to the unpaved areas of the park. 872 Fee of fencing will be required. Shane with Public Works has received bids for three different types of fencing material to be installed.
 - One option was installing a Cedar Split Rail Fence
 - Second option was installing a Buck N Rail Fence
 - Third Option was installing a vinyl 3 row fence
 - Fourth Option was to install Landscaping
 - Fifth option was to install a Fence and some landscaping, that would also help enhance the park area.
- 6. Comments were made about what areas of the park were part of the yearly maintenance agreement with Spectrum, what parts were maintained by the city and what the plan was on Maintenance for the Burgi Hill Park area. Shane with the City printed a map showing the different items to the Parks and Trails Committee.
- 7. Question was asked about weed maintenance from the past and what is planned for in the future.
- 8. Water questions were asked. Committee would like to know what type of water shares we have, if there enough to promote more landscaping of non-landscaped areas of the current park. Who owns and maintains the water in the ditch that runs through the park.
- 9. The ditch that runs north and south had questions of what it is used for and who uses it.
- 10. Questions were asked about the water area that floods south of the restrooms and west along the should have interlocked road. Where does the water flow to after it leaves the park.
- 11. Park meeting was closed.
- 12. Talked about a couple pieces of equipment we budgeted for parks and trails this year that would be coming soon.
