 - Small parcel draft 1-17-23 with City Council work meeting
 - Straw Poll from City Council on document

- C. Brad Winger from Preserve Midway reported on the Volksmarch event
 - They were able to raise funds
 - They are discussing how to best run the event
 - Mayor Johnson talked about the "Welcome Midway Packet" for all new residents and there will be about 100 of the packets to be sent out in 2023
- D. Small Parcel Document
 - Natalie Streeter introduced the document
 - Put education first

- Mayor Johnson discussed that small parcels could tap into bond money and the city could possibly pay some costs, such as survey and approved out of the funds
- Courtland discussed a pre-established value system per acre to pay for small parcels
- Steve Stevens discussed creating a small parcel group to focus on this issue and to help landowners
- Glen Lent submitted a flow chart that navigates an applicant route through the process
- Wendy discussed a system in Maryland that the landowner would be higher on the list depending on the amount of leverage of funds to maximize public funds
- Cheryl Fox commented a required donation might affect taxes
- Mayor Johnson explained #4 and #5 are not a process and should be moved earlier in the document
- E. Certified Land Trusts
 - Wendy Fisher shared a map
 - Laren Gertsch has talked with CLT about preservation
