






PURPOSE

The purpose of these grants is to increase participation in the arts in Wasatch County by offering a source of funding to help promote, advertise, and develop arts organizations and events.

APPLICATIONS

We opened the application process in January this year. We received nine applications, four of which were new groups who had not applied before. Awardees were selected by an independent panel of local business professionals & community members.


