

# Midway Historic Preservation Committee Minutes

1. Call to Order:
2. The August 27, 2024 meeting minutes were reviewed and accepted.
3. Agenda Items:
  - Homestead Virginia House Plans Review:  
The committee reviewed the plans that the Homestead submitted. The committee agree that the presented plans are acceptable for the Virginia House restoration. The committee wants to ensure that the National Historic Registry plaque remains on the building in a visible space.
  - Historic home art event:  
The Paint the Town event will take place in the community center from October 11 to 12, 2024. On Friday, October 11, the hours will be from 6 to 9 p.m., and on Saturday, October 12, from 10 am to 3pm.  
Set-up will be on Thursday, Oct. 10, at 2:30 p.m., and take-down will be on Saturday, Oct. 12, at 3 p.m.  
Launa Nielson from the DUP will present on Friday night at 7pm. Athina proposed asking Chris Jones to play music on Friday night. The committee agreed to ask Chris about music.  
Athina will take invitations to the residents of the local historic homes.  
Jim Kohler agreed to do a display table with Midway geology information.  
Banners are up and social media will be used for advertising.  
Camille will invite Mayor Johnson  
Committee members were asked to submit their time availability to Camille to coordinate a volunteer schedule.
  - Historic Markers:  
Diann Glenn reported that many of the markers are ready for production. She is waiting for approval from the Hardy Foundation, which owns several of the historic homes that will receive markers.  
There is a need for some photos of some properties to produce line drawings for the plaques.
  - Oral Histories:  
Athina will conduct oral history interviews on Oct. 15 with Jim Kohler and on Oct. 20 with the Lundeens.  
Mike Glenn moved to approve a hard drive purchase up to \$150. Diann Glenn seconded the motion, which was approved by the committee.
